- Consider adding photos of things you've made or repaired.

NAIL THE INTERVIEW.

Manufacturers value curiosity, precision, and learning.

- Talk about how you follow step-by-step instructions.
- Ask questions about how their products are made.
- Take notes to show you're engaged and ready to grow.
- Highlight experience that shows your relevant knowledge and skills.
